Radarclass units predominantly monitor speeds and in this location around a junction, such a deployment would not usually be progressed as speeds will be naturally very low around such areas. In terms of traffic flow monitoring, this is undertaken routinely via placement of rubber coated electrical loops in the carriageway and the last data we have for the village is from 2017, therefore relatively recently which I provide below:

- The average annual daily traffic for Antron Hill (from Kernick roundabout) is 5800 vehicles.
- The average annual daily traffic for Antron Hill (from the crossroads to Longdowns) is 3300 vehicles.
- The average annual daily traffic for Treliiever Road is 2200 vehicles.
- The average annual daily traffic for Church Road is 3700.
